- Solicitor
- Local or County Councillor
- Minister of Religion
- Accountant
- Bank or Building Society Official
- Independent Financial Advisor
- Post Office
- Dentist
- Police Officer
- Teacher
- Lecturer

Certified documents must include the wording, 'I Certify this as a true copy of the original'.

We also need the certification to include the following -

- Signed and dated within the last 3 months.
- Printing their name under the signature clearly.
- Adding their occupation, business address, and telephone number.
